Example: Joe DeMolay arrives at Conclave and enters into the Senator category. Joe competes in the 50m dash (a Senator event), but does not win. Joe is awarded 2 points. Joe then plays checkers (a Senator event) and wins! He is awarded 5 points. Joe then competes in Simon Says (a Gladiator event). Joe doesn't win, so he is awarded 1 point. Joe plays Spikeball (a General event) and wins, earning 3 points. Joe's point total is 11 points. Joe can compete in any and all events as many times possible.

Legion of Conclave

Point Distribution for Each Activity

Members of a category (Caesar, Senator, General, Gladiator) who participate in an event of their own category will be awarded 2 points for participating or 5 points if declared the victor. All other members will be awarded 1 point for participating or 3 points if the victory.

Initiatory Degree Candidates

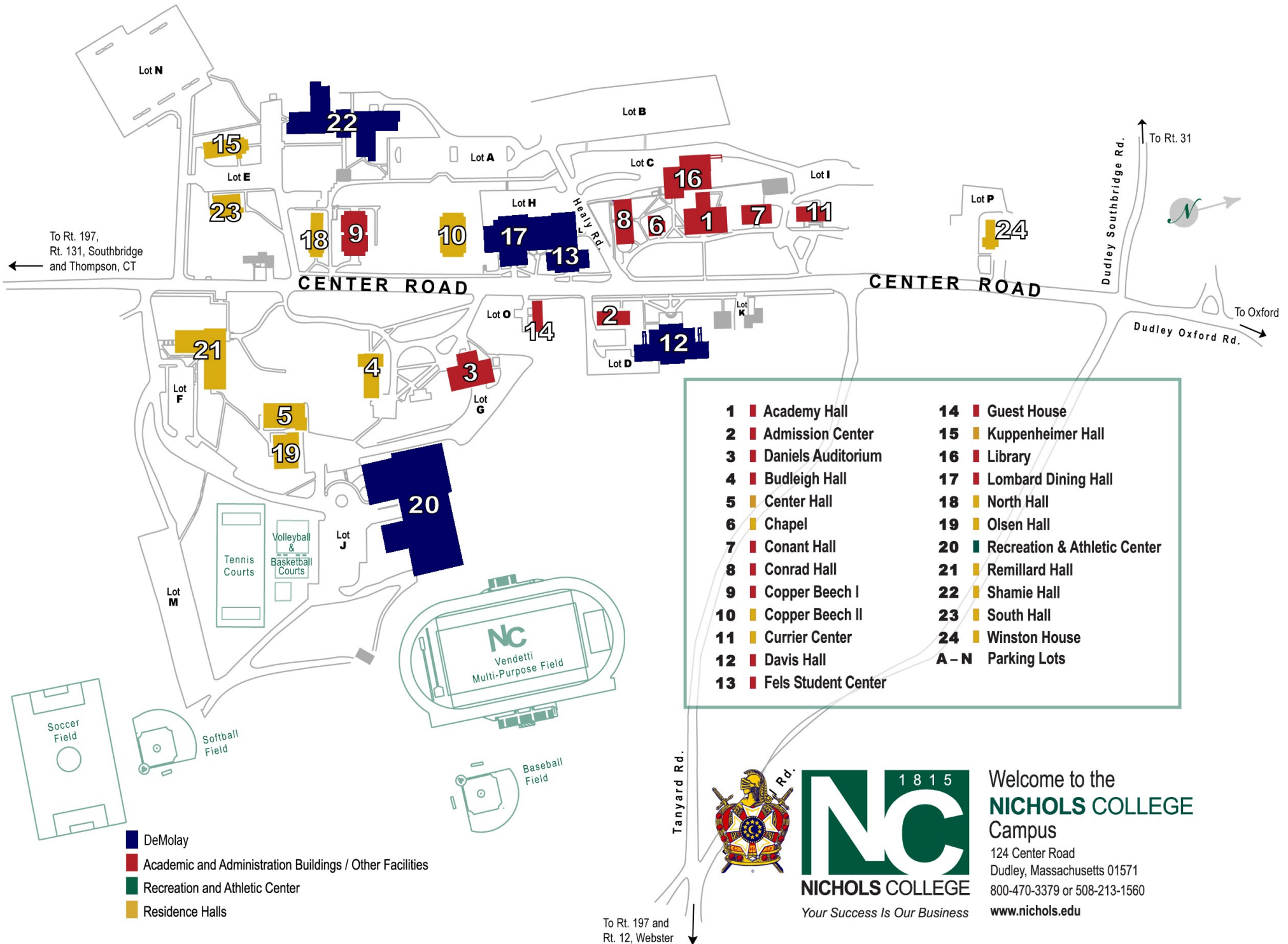
Candidates for the Initiatory Degree should arrive at the Fels Student Center at 6 pm on Friday to check-in with the State Suite representative.
